Saturday Parade

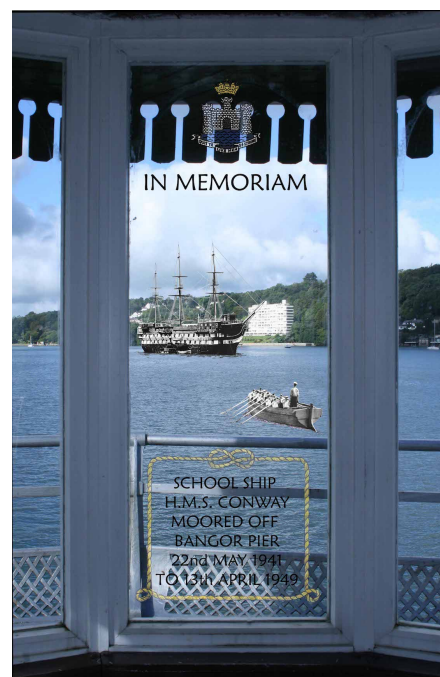
- All OCs expected to march behind the Conway ensign except those in the sick party!

DRIVING INSTRUCTIONS FOR LUNCH:

- Turn right out of pier car park.
- Turn left in front of Eryl Mor Hotel onto Upper Garth Road.
- Follow road up hill.
- It turns into College Road at the two story block of flats on the left.
- Keep straight on up hill,
- After entrance to the block of flats turn left into College Road by BBC Cymru sign on corner - marked as a dead end.
- Entrance to Management Centre is first right – about 150 yards.
